We saw a significant growth in interest this year around the Steering Committee elections, with over two-thirds participation in the two voting constituencies (government and science/civil society). There was also a significant number of candidates (five for the government constituency and two for Science and Civil Society); there were two additional candidates from science and civil society, but their candidacies, unfortunately, arrived after the deadline!

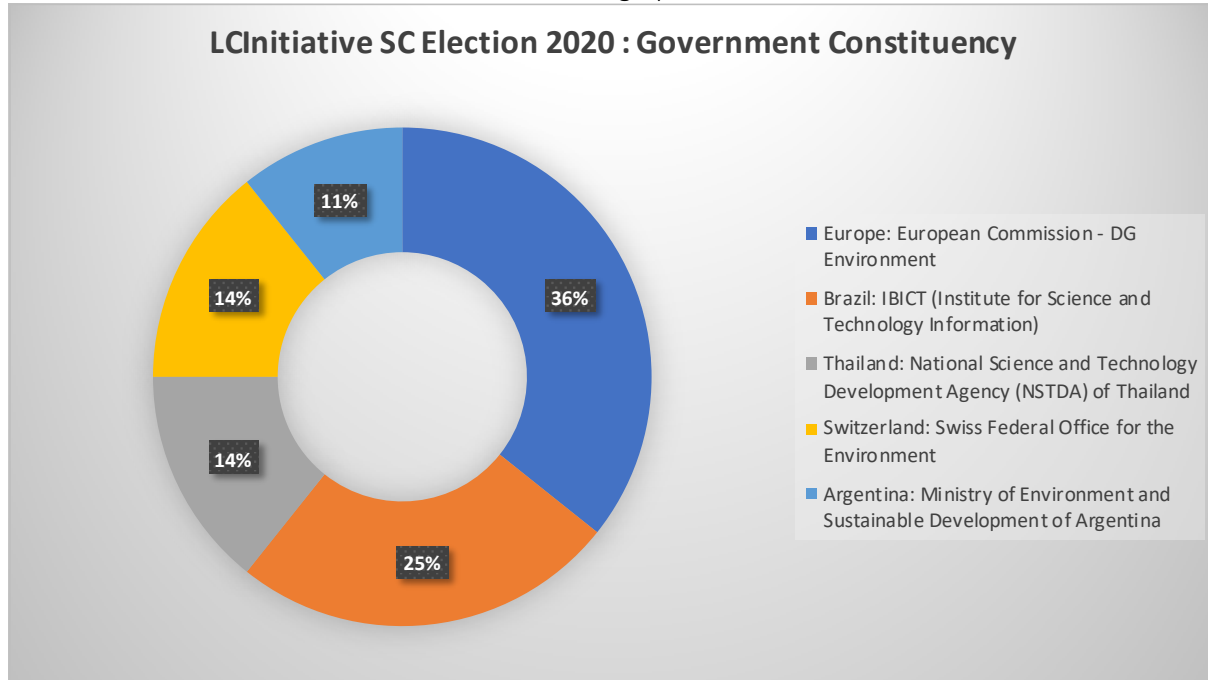

### Results for the Government constituency (2 seats)

Five candidates presented for election. As two seats were open, each eligible member cast two votes. With 70% participation of all eligible voters, the new elected government representatives to the Steering Committee are:

- European Commission – DG ENVIRONMENT
- IBICT

## Results for the Business constituency (1 seat)

Only one candidate presented for the open seat there was no vote. The automatically, newly elected representative to the Steering Committee for this constituency is:

- **The HUB EPD of Latin America "HUB EPD LATAM" (Latin America and Caribbean) [mandate until 2021].**

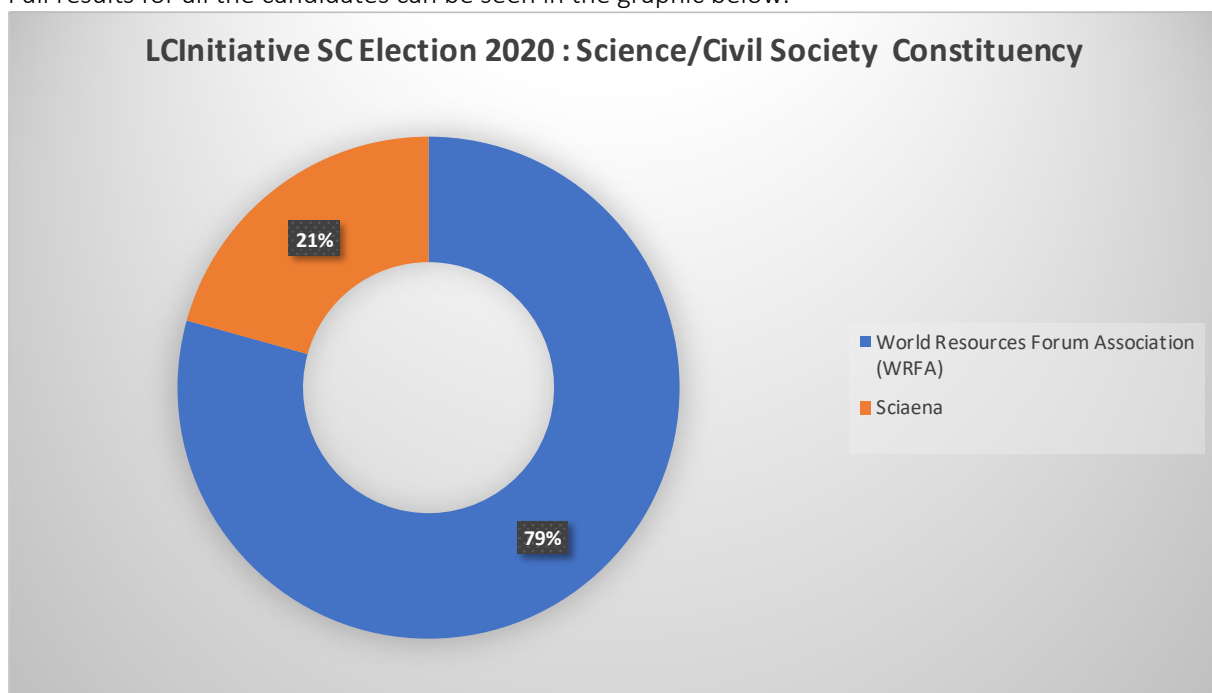
